

Zonta Club of Caboolture 16 Days of Activism, 25 November to 10 December

Annually Zonta Clubs across the world unite to advocate to eliminate gender-based violence and to 'paint' cities and neighbourhoods orange for the Zonta International, *16 Days of Activism against Gender-based Violence* campaign, in collaboration with the United Nations. This campaign runs from 25 November to 10 December each year to raise awareness of domestic and family violence in the community and to support change across communities.

The Zonta Club of Caboolture orange banners, "Zonta Says No", will be hung in prominent areas around the community. The banner is part of the Zonta 16 days of activism campaign to raise awareness of and action to Say No to Violence against Women. The Caboolture Hub will be lit with Orange to engage the community to join the campaign.

The Zonta Club of Caboolture, members of Zonta International, raise funds annually to support local projects towards a common goal – to Build a Better World for Women and Children. Clubs are not for profit, run by volunteers and all funds raised are directed to projects, such as educational scholarships for women, support to women refugees and domestic violence support services.

Zonta Caboolture is part of Zonta International District 22. One of the key activities for our Clubs in this campaign is profiling on social media to boost awareness. Each day we will be posting content to our Zonta *FaceBook* and Instagram pages about the campaign and what local community members can do to support it.
