#### Zonta Club of Caboolture 16 Days of Activism, 25 November to 10 December

Annually Zonta Clubs across the world unite to advocate to eliminate gender-based violence and to

'paint' cities and neighbourhoods orange for the Zonta International, 16 Days of Activism against Gender-based Violence campaign, in collaboration with the United Nations. This campaign runs from 25 November to 10 December each year to raise awareness of domestic and family violence in the community and to support change across communities.

The Zonta Club of Caboolture orange banners, "Zonta Says No", will be hung in prominent areas around the community. The banner is part of the Zonta 16 days of activism campaign to raise awareness of and action to Say No to Violence against Women. The Caboolture Hub will be lit with Orange to engage the community to join the campaign.
